- No time to do formal project close off and lessons learned analysis

Some see:

- Need for more rigour around Project Organisation and roles and responsibilities
- Need for improved stakeholder management and tracking versus desired outcomes
- Poor project controls to track quality and progress for communication to stakeholders
- Over-planning and too strict an adherence to project methodologies v pragmatism
- Lack of understanding or focus on real business priorities and impact
- Heavy reliance on resource that is running the day to day operations

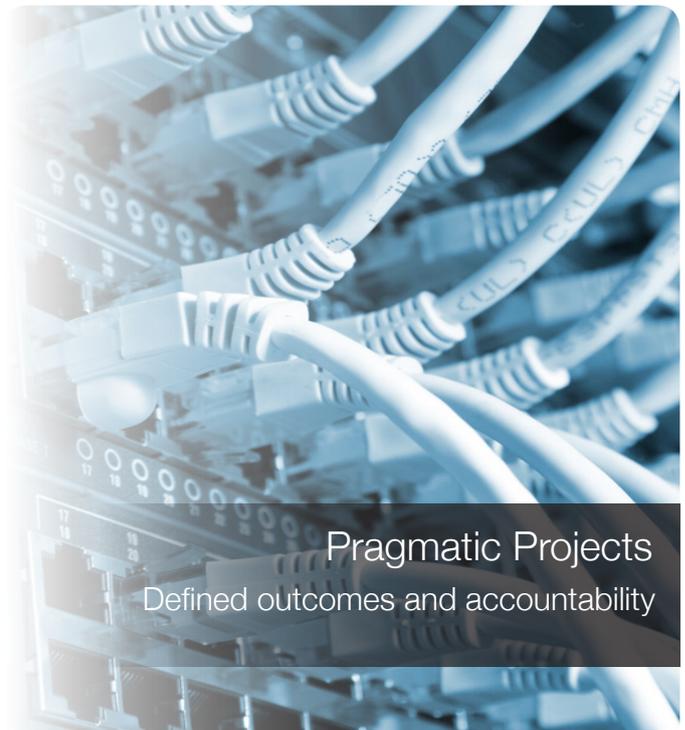
What to expect from CloudTalent
